Whereas the University has chosen the worst possible time and circumstances to experiment with paid and reserved faculty parking, a decision that conspicuously aggravates our campus parking problem, the Faculty Senate urges the administration to suspend this program immediately and until at least after the CCR project is completed. Fundamental reconsideration of the concept also is warranted in view of the small minority of faculty who prefer paid parking, and the potentially divisive impact of the program on faculty relations.
